Coffee and Chat every Wednesday morning has increased in popularity, and we are planning a fundraiser for Breast Cancer Now in the summer. Everyone is most welcome.

Hallam School PTFA organised an extremely successful annual fete, supported by HCYA, with many fun activities and a large attendance, thanks to excellent weather. This year's fete will be held on Saturday 4th July. We hosted a Christmas Wreath making session, which was a great success and will return in 2026 by popular demand. HCYA also supported the Sheffield Hospital Charities Christmas tree recycling, when the Hall was used as the hub to co-ordinate the collection teams. January was brightened by an excellent Whisky tasting evening presented by StarmoreBoss and we have plans for a port/sherry tasting later this year. We were also delighted to be selected as the venue for an additional Polling Station for the local Council elections held on 7th May.

Finally, I would like to thank you all for your continued support, in addition to the SouthwestLAC and our local Councillors, and look forward to working with you over the coming years.

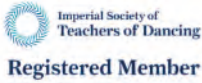


